Alec Oxenford is an Argentine serial entrepreneur focused on the Internet Space. In March of 2006, Alec co-founded OLX.com with business partner Fabrice Grinda in the hopes of building the largest online classifieds platform. As Co-Founder and Brand Champion, Alec leads the company from its Buenos Aires office. With over 200 million monthly unique users, OLX is the #1 online classifieds player in Brazil, in India and in 18 other Emerging Markets in Asia, Latin America and Africa.

OLX's 600 employees work from 9 offices in Buenos Aires, Cape Town, Delhi, Karachi, Lagos, Nairobi, New York, Rio de Janeiro and Sao Paulo. Naspers Media Group acquired a controlling stake in OLX in 2010.

Prior to OLX, in 1999, Alec co-founded DeRemate.com, an online trading platform for Latam which was sold to eBay in 2005. In 2003 Alec also co-founded DineroMail.com, a regional payment platform. Before becoming an entrepreneur, Alec worked as a business consultant for BCG in Europe and Latin America.

Alec is an avid collector of contemporary art and he was elected President of ArteBA (a contemporary art fair, 2013). Alec was also elected Young Global Leader by the World Economic Forum and he graduated as MBA with Distinction from Harvard Business School (97).
